PROTECTING LIVES, SCALING THE MOUNT EVEREST OF MEDICINE WITH TECHNOLOGY

Sports Medicine >>>

Case 1 is the first in Guangdong Province



The Sports Medicine Department is led by Director Lu Wei, a renowned sports medicine expert and core member of China's sports medicine specialty. It aims to build an internationally advanced shoulder joint center and articular cartilage repair center, providing specialized disease diagnosis and treatment services.

Case 1: Successfully performed Guangdong Province's first arthroscopic anterior cruciate ligament reconstruction (double-bundle LARS ligament reconstruction) using an innovative technique with a tolerance accuracy of only 1 millimeter, helping a 35-year-old badminton player with anterior cruciate ligament tear combined with meniscal tear return to the field sooner.

Case 2: Pioneered the internationally advanced Collagen-Induced Autologous Chondrocyte Implantation (ACIC) in China, offering patients with cartilage damage a more advanced and long-lasting treatment option.

Case 3: Performed multiple LUtarjet procedures under shoulder arthroscopy (a surgery named after Director Lu Wei), which are among the most difficult surgeries in sports medicine with the best return-to-sport outcomes.

Urology >>>



The Urology Department is led by Director Liu Jiumin, former Director of Urology at Guangdong Provincial People's Hospital and recipient of the "Golden Scalpel Award" for minimally invasive urological surgery in Guangdong Province. He has rich clinical experience in the diagnosis and treatment of urological tumors, urolithiasis, congenital malformations, as well as andrology and kidney transplantation; proficient in robot-assisted surgery, laparoscopic techniques, and minimally invasive treatment of urolithiasis and other advanced surgical techniques.

The department continuously performs various highly difficult robot-assisted laparoscopic minimally invasive surgeries, widely covering urological tumors, pelvic tumors, adrenal tumors, and other areas of the urinary system.

Respiratory Medicine >>>



The Respiratory Medicine Department is led by Professor Zhao Ziwen, former Director of Respiratory and Critical Care Medicine Department at Guangzhou First People's Hospital and the first Lingnan Famous Doctor. He has long been engaged in the diagnosis, treatment, and research of respiratory system-related diseases, specializing in the diagnosis and treatment of critically ill respiratory patients and respiratory interventional diagnosis and treatment techniques.

Has performed several Grade IV bronchoscopic interventional surgeries at the industry's leading level, such as endobronchial valve implantation and stent implantation, all achieving good efficacy and receiving positive feedback from patients.

Led by Professor Wang Zhiping, in collaboration with the First Affiliated Hospital of Sun Yat-sen University, a first-class cardiothoracic and vascular center has been established, including Departments of Cardiac Surgery, Cardiology, and Thoracic Surgery:

Cardiac Surgery >>>



The Cardiac Surgery Department is led by Professor Wang Zhiping, former Director of the Cardiac Surgery Department at the First Affiliated Hospital of Sun Yat-sen University. He is proficient in coronary artery bypass grafting, valvular heart disease, great vessel disease, congenital heart disease, and heart transplantation, and has pioneered several cardiac surgery techniques internationally. The Department has continuously performed multiple highly complex cardiac surgery core techniques, such as valve repair/replacement, congenital heart disease correction, and coronary artery bypass grafting. All patients were transferred out of the intensive care unit (ICU) within 24 hours post-surgery.

Case 1: Successfully repaired a "ruptured" heart for a 37-year-old emergency male patient. The patient suddenly suffered aortic sinus aneurysm rupture, leading to acute right heart failure and liver and kidney injury. The Department performed emergency aortic sinus aneurysm repair, tricuspid valve plasty, and pacemaker implantation, successfully saving his life.

Case 2: Successfully completed a "combination punch" for a patient from Xinjiang, one surgery with simultaneously completed coronary artery bypass grafting, left ventricular aneurysmectomy, thrombus removal, left ventricular plasty, and endarterectomy for blocked vessels, which is one of the most complex cardiac surgeries.

Cardiology >>>

Case 1 and 2 are the first in Shenzhen



Case 1: Performed Shenzhen's first transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) with cerebral protection, hailed as "cardiac micro-sculpting." This not only brought "rebirth" to a 76-year-old patient with severe aortic valve stenosis and end-stage chronic heart failure but also filled a technological gap in Shenzhen.

Case 2: Technology First: Bioresorbable Vascular Scaffold. Dr. Chenghu Hu's interventional cardiology team performed Shenzhen's first "Hong Kong-Macao Drug and Device Channel" implantation of a magnesium-based bioresorbable coronary scaffold for a patient with coronary artery disease. Following this index case, the team has completed multiple consecutive procedures, establishing Qianhai as an early access site for next-generation coronary devices not yet widely available in mainland China.

Case 3: Performed a highly difficult triple-chamber pacemaker (cardiac resynchronization defibrillator CRT-D) implantation surgery, bringing hope to complex heart disease patients with coronary heart disease, old myocardial infarction, ischemic cardiomyopathy, cardiomegaly, complete left bundle branch block, and Class IV heart failure.

Case 4: In collaboration with Professor Long Ming, a member of Director Liao Xinxue's renowned doctor studio in the Cardiovascular Medical Division at the First Affiliated Hospital of Sun Yat-sen University, performed percutaneous transcatheter closure of patent foramen ovale (PFO), successfully sealing the abnormal channel in the heart and fundamentally preventing potential thromboembolic events such as stroke.

Thoracic Surgery >>>

Case 1 is the first in Shenzhen



Case 1: Director of Thoracic Surgery Professor Chen Kailin, in collaboration with Director of Nephrology Professor Wu Kun, successfully performed a mediastinal tumor resection without thoracotomy for a patient with a mediastinal mass. This was Shenzhen's first transsternal ectopic parathyroidectomy.

This 50-year-old male patient from Hunan had been undergoing dialysis for more than ten years due to renal failure. Starting five years ago, he experienced a series of symptoms including generalized itching, bone pain, osteoporosis, and stubborn hypertension, leading to a diagnosis of secondary renal hyperparathyroidism.

This surgery resolved the patient's long-standing problem of unexplained hyperparathyroidism, demonstrating the hospital's comprehensive strength in multidisciplinary collaboration for complex cases.

Case 2: A 79-year-old patient with malignant tumor of the right middle and lower lung. After 4 cycles of chemotherapy combined with immunotherapy, the tumor did not shrink significantly, and the patient gradually became emaciated. Due to extensive tumor invasion, severe hilar adhesion (possibly "frozen hilum"), and poor cardiopulmonary function, the patient underwent "single-port thoracoscopic right middle and lower lobectomy + bronchoplasty + intrapericardial pulmonary vessel management + mediastinal lymph node dissection" at our hospital. The surgery was extremely difficult and risky, and the patient has now recovered and been discharged.

Sun Yat-sen University + Southern Medical University, led by President Chen Minhu, from a dream team, creating a first-class Digestive Medicine Center, including Gastroenterology, Hepatobiliary Surgery, and Gastrointestinal Surgery:

Digestive Endoscopy >>>



The Digestive Endoscopy Department is led by Professor Li Chujun, former Director of the Digestive Endoscopy Department at the Sixth Affiliated Hospital, Sun Yat-sen University, a "Lingnan Famous Doctor" and "Yangcheng Good Doctor", with over 100,000 digestive endoscopy procedures performed. He has rich experience in clinical and endoscopic diagnosis and treatment of digestive system diseases, including esophageal, gastrointestinal, hepatobiliary, and pancreatic disorders.

Case 1: Successfully performed "super minimally invasive" incisionless endoscopic retrograde appendicitis treatment (ERAT), achieving fast recovery due to minimally invasive treatment.

Case 2: Successfully performed endoscopic minimally invasive resection of a huge duodenal descending mass (4cm+) combined with ERCP (endoscopic retrograde cholangiopancreatography) for a 76-year-old patient from Shunde, Foshan.

Hepatobiliary Surgery >>>



The Hepatobiliary Surgery Department is led by Professor Zhou Jie, former Director of Hepatobiliary-Pancreatic Surgery and Liver Transplant Center at Nanfang Hospital, Southern Medical University. He has over 40 years of frontline clinical experience in hepatobiliary-pancreatic surgery, having successfully diagnosed and treated hundreds of cases of benign and malignant hepatobiliary-pancreatic tumors such as liver cancer, cholangiocarcinoma, and pancreatic cancer, treated over a thousand cases of cholelithiasis, and performed over 200 liver transplants, one-third of which achieved zero blood transfusion.

Currently, he has performed multiple complex major liver surgeries in our hospital, including hepatectomy for liver cancer, hepatectomy for colorectal cancer liver metastasis, and cavernous hemangioma resection.

A patient with a congenital choledochal cyst even followed Director Zhou Jie for 35 years, from Dongguan to Shenzhen, to seek his expertise for a highly difficult biliary surgery.

Gastrointestinal Surgery >>>



Case: In collaboration with Professor Chen Zhihui from the Gastrointestinal Surgery Department, the First Affiliated Hospital of Sun Yat-sen University, a highly difficult and complex laparoscopic surgery was completed for Crohn's disease, a type of surgery rarely performed in Shenzhen.

The patient had been emaciated with unformed stools for half a year, suggesting active Crohn's disease with intestinal stricture and internal fistula. The patient had visited multiple hospitals, but drug treatment was ineffective. Later, he traveled from Shenzhen to Guangzhou to seek his expertise, and finally followed him to Shenzhen Qianhai Taikang Hospital.

After examining the patient, Professor Chen recommended active surgical treatment followed by drug treatment, and coordinated with experts from the First Affiliated Hospital of Sun Yat-sen University, Director Zhou Jie's team from the General Surgery Department, Director Chen Qikui's team from the Gastroenterology Department, and the Anesthesia Center of this hospital, successfully completing laparoscopic right hemicolectomy, partial ileum resection, and sigmoid colon fistula repair.

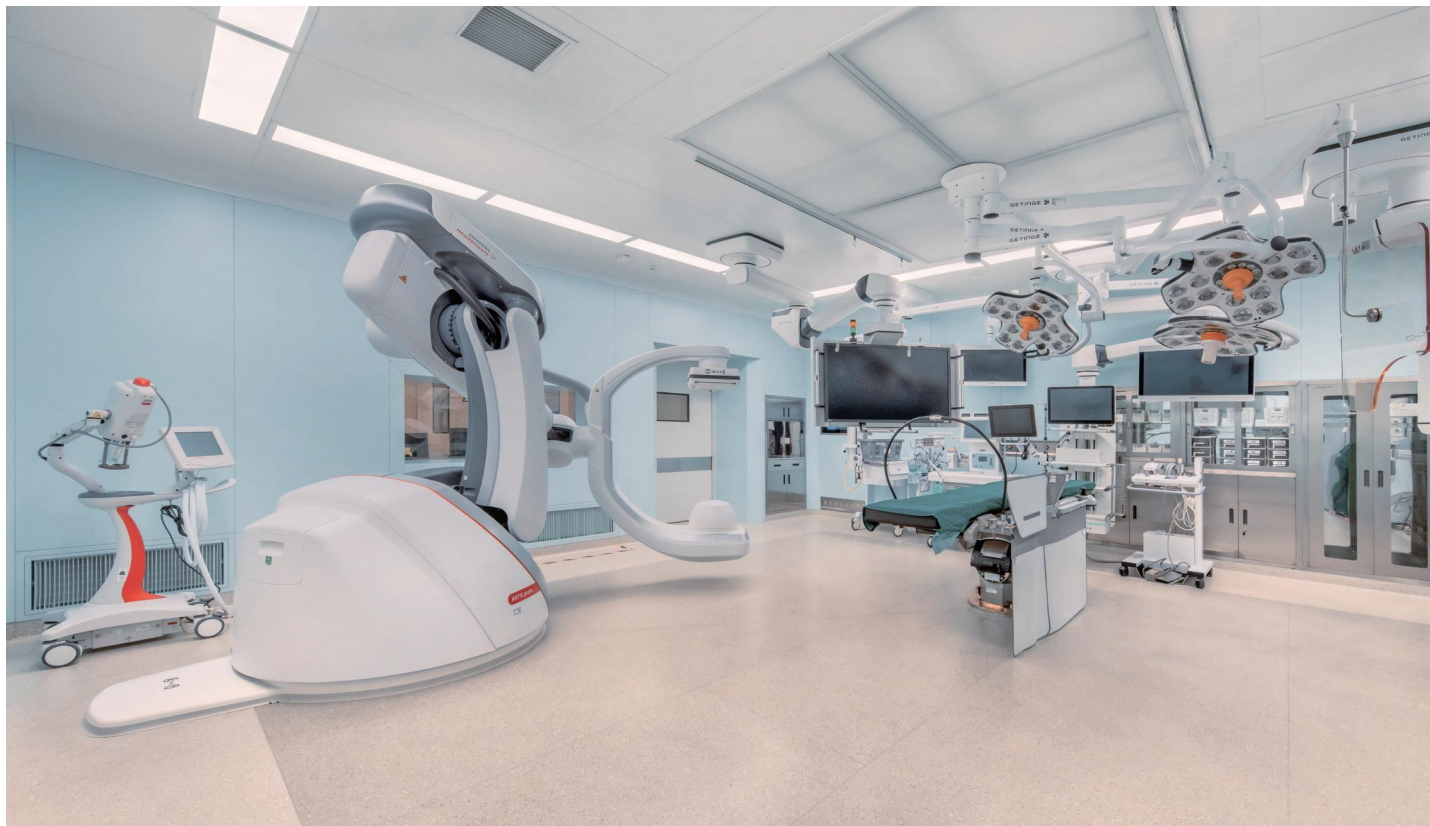

Wuhan University Taikang Medical College

In November 2021, Wuhan University Taikang Medical School was unveiled. In December of the same year, Wuhan University Taikang Center for Life and Medical Sciences was officially established, with Academician Song Baoliang of the Chinese Academy of Sciences serving as the center's director/chief scientist. Wuhan University Taikang Medical School (School of Basic Medical Sciences) and Taikang Center for Life and Medical Sciences will be built into a high-level talent cluster integrating "medical care, teaching, and research" and a world-class life medical research and education institution. In 2024, a total of 13 experts from Taikang Healthcare served as professors, adjunct professors, or graduate supervisors at Wuhan University.



Hospital Scientific Research Dynamics

Professor Chen Minhu has been selected as one of the "Top 2% Global Scientists" for three consecutive years and "Highly Cited Chinese Researcher" for four consecutive years. He has published over 500 research articles in top domestic and international journals such as the Lancet and JAMA, including over 400 SCI-indexed articles. Young Pharmacist Dr. Yu Haoying successfully obtained a grant from National Natural Science Foundation of China during the hospital's preparatory period. The Pharmacy Division she belongs to won the 2022 Pharmaceutical Science and Technology Achievement Award and multiple provincial pharmaceutical funds. In addition, the hospital is equipped with a central laboratory and a biobank to support applied basic research and clinical application research.

Taikang Young Medical Research Seed Fund

To cultivate outstanding young medical research talents with development and competitive potential, Taikang has specially established a Young Medical Research Seed Fund to support young talents in conducting scientific research. As of November 2025, 17 young and backbone physicians in the hospital have successfully applied for and received funding from the scientific research seed fund.

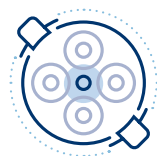

It is equipped with a strong team of anesthesiologists who can provide pain management for patients outside the operating room, including pain-free endoscopy, comfortable dental treatment, and pain-free childbirth.



Comfortable Dental Treatment

Provides a full process of pain-free and comfortable dental treatment experience, including comfortable tooth extraction, filling, and treatment.



Pain-Free Endoscopy

The Endoscopy Center offers various pain-free techniques, with anesthesia administered by professional anesthesiologists, ensuring pain-free experience and comfort throughout gastroscopy, colonoscopy, and other endoscopic examinations and treatments.



Pain-Free Childbirth

Allows expectant mothers to no longer endure the torment of pain, reducing fear during childbirth and postpartum fatigue.

"Pain-free" is not just about "pain relief", but also about "pain elimination". The hospital has established a professional pain clinic to treat various types of pain for patients.



Bone and Joint & Soft Tissue Pain >>>

A patient stated: "I am a patient with recurring frozen shoulder. Half a year ago, my left shoulder hurt badly, and I tried various treatments in many places without success. With a try-and-see attitude, I came to the Pain Clinic of Shenzhen Qianhai Taikang Hospital. Dr. Wang from the Anesthesiology Department "relieved my pain with a single injection".



Postoperative Scar Pain >>>

Mr. Chen from Sichuan underwent coronary artery bypass grafting more than ten years ago, and his cardiac function recovered very well after the surgery. *Single room bed fees are independently priced.



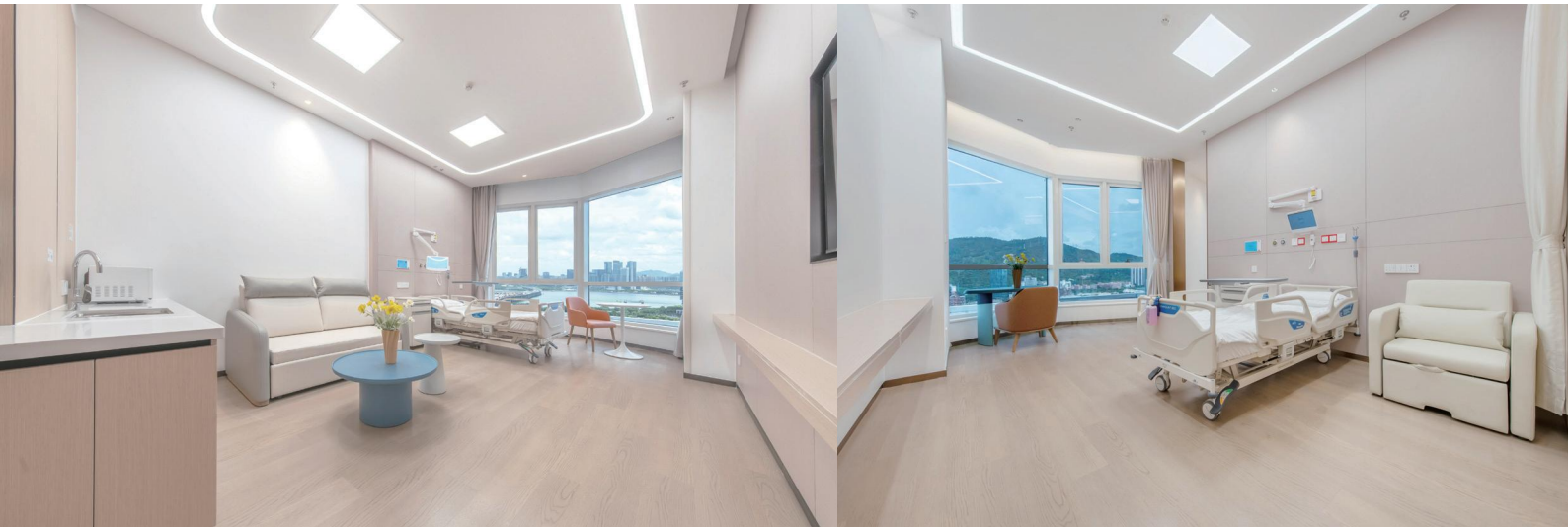
